Description: The role of the Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC) is to make recommendations to the Select Board about the improvement of the safety of the public ways in Belmont for pedestrian, bicycle, and vehicle traffic.

Responsibilities include:

- Propose studies, under the direction of the Town Engineer, to help develop pedestrian, bicyclist, and traffic management recommendations to the Select Board.
- Evaluate traffic Issues, such as parking and parking restrictions, turn restrictions and traffic calming and safety techniques/locations including signage improvements, crosswalk identification; intersection configuration; motor vehicle parking management; regulatory and directional signs; speeding of motor vehicles; traffic configurations; all under the direction of the Town Engineer.
- Develop revised or new policies, all under the direction of the Town Engineer, relevant to pedestrian, bicyclist, and vehicle traffic management.

The Town Engineer shall be the point of contact between the Committee and any Town departments, including the Police and Fire Departments and DPW.

Criteria for Membership: The Committee shall be appointed by the Select Board for staggered two (2) year terms, including the following members:

- 9 Residents, including at least 1 member of Safe Routes to Schools
- Ex-Officio Town Engineer or Designee (non-voting)
