EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES

- Advanced life support care (paramedics) provided by Rescue 1 as well as firefighter/paramedics working on fire companies
- ▶ Incident volume on a "normal" year is about 1800 EMS responses
- Average response time by Belmont Fire/Rescue units is 4:36
- Private EMS standards= 90% of calls in 11:59

BASIC COST FOR PARAMEDIC RESCUE UNIT

- Vehicle-\$370,000 (cost budgeted over 5 years)
- Cardiac Monitor- \$35,000
- Personnel (8) salary/ benefits-\$696,000

Total cost= \$1,096,000

CURRENT EMS BILLING STRUCTURE

- Original model from inception of paramedic service
- ▶ Billing structure and fees not updated in over 10 years
- Considerably less reimbursement amounts than almost all surrounding cities and towns
- Current "a la carte" fee structure not supported by modern medical billing codes- resulting in many services not receiving reimbursement
