Modeled after English Rain Barrels, the Great American Rain Barrel is a recycled shipping container that holds 60 gallons of precious rain water. Our barrel is one of the largest capacity rain barrels available today! It is also the best built and most durable with a wall thickness of 3/16" resulting in a rigid, heavy duty rain barrel that will last virtually forever.

The Great American Rain Barrel is fully re-purposed and comes with the following parts:

- ▶ insect screen
- ▶ screw-on lid
- ▶ 2 x 3/4" overflow valves
- ▶ threaded plastic spigot
- ▶ drain plug
- ▶ optional connection valve

You also have a choice between two ports to place your spigot.

Specs 60 gallons, food grade, UV protected and highly durable 3/16" polyethylene.

Dimensions 39" tall, 24" Diameter and 20 lbs. empty.

Colors Barrels are offered painted or unpainted. Choose from 3 environmentally compatible colors: Earth Brown, Nantucket Gray and Forest Green or the original unpainted color of dark gray or black.

Installation Our rain barrel only takes minutes to set up. The spigot, overflow valve and complete directions are packaged inside the barrel. All you need to do is level the ground, prepare the downspout, insert the spigot and overflow valve in the pre-drilled holes and wait for rain!

The Save the Rain Diverter™ is offered separately. The diverter captures water fast and efficiently without harming your downspout; no risk of water backing up into your gutter system.
