



COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic



The Belmont Health Department is offering COVID-19 vaccines to eligible residents, including 1st, 2nd, and booster shots. This clinic will be operated through a partnership between VaxinateRX and the Belmont Health Department, Pfizer and Moderna vaccines will be available.

NEW: Those 5 -11 can now sign up to receive a booster dose if it has been at least 5 months since their second dose.

- Those 5+ can sign up for the appropriate 1st, 2nd, or booster dose as eligible
- Those 50+ can sign up for a 2nd booster, 4+ months after their first booster
- Those 12+ with certain medical conditions may get a second booster at least 4 months after first booster (Pfizer for 12+, and Pfizer or Moderna for 18+)
- Those 18+ who received both a primary and booster dose of Johnson & Johnson vaccine may get a booster of either Moderna or Pfizer at least 4 months after their Johnson & Johnson booster.
