

Vaccine Catch up Clinic



The Belmont Health Department in partnership with VaxxinateRX, will be offering a clinic for individuals to receive vaccines that they may be behind on or missing altogether. If you are an adult, and it has been more than 10 years since your last tetanus containing vaccine, you may be eligible to receive a TDAP (Tetanus, Diphtheria, and Pertussis) vaccine at our upcoming clinic. This is recommended especially if you have young children, or spend time around young children.

<u>TDAP</u>	1 dose required for school entry, and 1 additional dose is recommended if you have not received any tetanus containing vaccines in the past 10 years.

Kids' Vaccine Catch up Clinic

The Belmont Health Department in partnership with VaxxinateRX, will be offering a clinic for individuals to receive vaccines that they may be behind on or missing altogether. At this clinic, MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella), TDAP (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis), and Meningitis vaccines will be available. Individuals ages 11+ can receive TDAP and Meningitis vaccines at this clinic, and anyone school-aged can receive MMR, if they are missing any of the doses listed below.

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Insurance is required to receive these vaccines. Please bring your insurance cards.

Vaccine	Dosage Information
<u>TDAP</u>	1 dose required for school entry, and 1 additional dose is recommended if you have not received any tetanus containing vaccines in the past 10 years.
<u>MMR</u>	2 doses required for school entry.
<u>Meningitis</u>	1 dose required for school entry grades 7-9. 2 doses required for school entry grades 11-12. Meningococcal B vaccine is not required and does not meet this requirement.

If you are not sure that your child has all of the required vaccines, please reach out to your pediatrician or school nurse.

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COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic

The Belmont Health Department is offering COVID-19 vaccines to eligible residents, including primary and booster shots. This clinic will be operated through a partnership between VaxinateRX and the Belmont Health Department. Pfizer and Moderna vaccines will be available as detailed below:

Current CDC recommendations include 1 bivalent COVID vaccine. If you've already received a bivalent COVID vaccine (first introduced in September 2022), you are considered up to date on your COVID vaccine.

- Primary vaccine series for anyone ages 3+ (At our clinics, only Pfizer is available for those under the age of 18)
- *Bivalent booster of Pfizer or Moderna COVID vaccine for anyone 3+ eligible who has completed a primary vaccine series of any authorized COVID-19 vaccine at least 2 months after last dose or last booster dose
- Flu shots will be available for ages 3+
