  - Idea #179 Shared Inspectors with Watertown
    - The committee agreed that this write-up is good, no edits
  - Idea #183 Maintenance Manuals

- o Idea #189 Reorganize Accounting Department
  - Vicki Amalfitano suggested adding a Next Steps bullet point that acknowledges the good work of the new Town Accountant and continue the good efforts toward improvement
  - Anne Helgen suggested adding a recommendation that the Accounting Department work with Treasurer's Office to reform payroll processing
- o Idea #201 Open Marijuana Retail Dispensaries
  - Joe Bernard suggested adding a clause stating the municipalities are required to maintain public records documenting community impact costs
- o Idea #212 Eliminate Citizen Building Committees
  - The committee agreed that this write-up is good, no edits
- o Idea #213 Have Fewer Select Board Meetings and Eliminate Pay to the Select Board
  - The committee agreed that this write-up is good, no edits
- Idea #215 Change Town Clerk Staffing
  - Aaron Pikcilingis suggested adding a recommendation to continue to have the Town Clerk as an elected position
  - Matt Gasbarro suggested adding a next step referring to the broader review that will be conducted by a Charter Review Committee
  - Norma Massarotti asked how to address the part of the idea text that suggests replacing the Assistant Town Clerk with a clerical person
  - Mark Paolillo suggested clarifying that the idea implies that an appointed Town Clerk might have stronger qualifications and that reducing the grade of the Assistant Town Clerk would have cost savings

  - Mark Paolillo suggested adding language explaining the underride mechanism provided in Proposition 2½
- o Idea #227 Allow Work from Home for Town Employees
  - Norma suggested clarifying language to identify positions/work that can be done remotely or in a hybrid working model, and adding a bullet point that recommends considering hot desking when evaluating a hybrid working model
- Idea #241 Issue Speeding Tickets Through Traffic Cameras
  - The committee agreed that this write-up is good, no edits
- o Idea #271 Tax Revenue from Short-Term Rentals
  - The committee agreed that this write-up is good, no edits
- Idea #293 Adjustments to Enrollment
  - Anne Helgen suggested clarifying language in the section about cutting FTEs from the originally proposed FY22 budget
